Board of Supervisors' Actions June 16, 2016 Business Meeting

LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP (*June 17, 2016*) – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at their June 16th business meeting:

Resolutions

- Adopted a resolution approving S-16-03, a subdivision plan creating two lots at 3837 Landis Mill Road

Waiver Requests

- Granted a waiver request for the new Starbucks to be constructed within the Audubon Square V project allowing the architect to follow the International Building Code (IBC) standard for the required amount of toilet facilities rather than the local plumbing code

Approvals

- Authorized an agreement with Marc Consulting for economic and business development assistance
- Authorized staff to proceed with upgrades to the Township phone system and replacement of the voicemail server
- Approved the engagement of David L. Woglom of the Meyner Center, Lafayette College, to conduct the search for a new Township Manager
