**Board of Supervisors' Actions – Dec. 1, 2016 Business Meeting**

**LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP** (December 2, 2016) – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at their December 1<sup>st</sup> business meeting, including adoption of the 2017 Budget that does not raise taxes for residents.

- Approved the request of Child & Family Focus for waiver of land development for installation of a shed at 920 Madison Avenue
- Approved a resolution adopting the 2017 Budget
- Approved a resolution establishing the 2017 real estate tax millage: .905 mills for General Purposes; .345 mills for the Library Fund; .276 mills for the Debt Service Fund and .241 mills for Parks and Recreation Operating Fund
- Approved a resolution adopting the 2017 Fee Schedule
- Approved the disposition of records
- Authorized the posting of Act 44 Disclosure Forms on the Township website
- Approved a resolution requesting a Multimodal Transportation Fund Grant of \$2 million from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for the Park Avenue, Eagleville Road, Crawford Road realignment.
