LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP (*June 16, 2017*) – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at the June 15th business meeting:

Approvals / Authorizations

- Approved the Consent Agenda, including:
 - Minutes of the June 1, 2017 Board of Supervisors meeting
 - Minutes of the May 22 workshop meeting of the Board of Supervisors and Lower Providence Fire Company
 - Authorization of the payment of bills totaling \$336,305.64
 - Payment of escrow release #2 for Audubon Square V in the amount of \$453,325.18

- Approved a 20-year lease agreement between Montgomery County and Lower Providence Township for the Audubon Recreation Fields

- Authorized the Solicitor to advertise an ordinance amending Section 143-11 of the Township Zoning Code concerning the extension of zoning district boundaries on split-zoned properties
