Board of Supervisors' Actions June 2, 2016 Business Meeting

LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP (*June 3, 2016*) – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at their June 2nd business meeting:

Resolutions

- Adopted a resolution approving a proposal for a two-lot subdivision separating a single-family detached dwelling from two apartment/storage buildings at 3854 and 3868 Germantown Pike

Waiver Requests

- Granted a request for waiver of land development for Tosco Restaurant, 2819 Ridge Pike, to permit construction of a parking area to allow for seasonal sales
- Granted a request for waiver of fence regulations at 3101 Sky Drive
- Granted a request for waiver of fence regulations at 360 Jamestown Circle
- Granted a request for waiver of sidewalk regulations at 25 Brant Road
- Granted the request of the Lower Providence Volunteer Fire Company for waiver of the temporary sign permit fee and for extension of operating hours to 11 p.m. on Fri., June 10 and Fri., June 17, and to 9 p.m. on Sun., June 12

Approvals

- Authorized the Township to participate with the Montgomery County Consortium of Communities to negotiate renewal of the Verizon Franchise Agreement
- Authorized the Township Solicitor to research the ownership of an open space parcel
